



School Board Election 2026

Voting Guide

Election Day: April 16, 2026

The School's Board must have a minimum of 5 elected members and a maximum of 11 elected members. There are currently 7 members.

Positions open for the board for the 2026 election:

Due to one member's board term ending, the board has up to 5 positions open for election. The school board must consist of at least one Minnesota state-licensed teacher employed by the school, one parent/legal guardian of a student currently enrolled in the school and not employed by the school, and one community member who is not employed by the school and does not have a child enrolled.

There are currently 2 parents, 1 community member, and 3 teachers. The candidates cannot be employees (other than licensed teachers) or related to an employee of Discovery Woods School.

Any person who is listed as a parent or guardian of a child(ren) on the admission forms shall be a member of the corporation concurrently with the enrollment of his or her child(ren) in the school under its current admissions policies. School faculty and staff shall be members of the corporation. Members of the Board of Directors shall also be members of the corporation. All members shall be of one class and have equal voting rights. Any member may insert his or her own name into nomination, or that of any other person who agrees to serve.

Ballots will be accepted beginning at 7:35 am on April 16, 2026, and all voting will be finalized by 3:00 pm on April 16, 2026. Ballots will be sent and accepted digitally via email, and hard copies will be available at the school's main office until 3:00 pm. The ballot box will be in the main office until 3:00 pm.
